KEY POINTS:	<ul> <li>Improving Access is a nationally mandated service for extending the opening times of primary care, on a hub basis</li> <li>There is a requirement to deliver 1.5 hours extra per evening (Monday to Friday, after 6:30 pm) and Saturday and Sunday appointments</li> <li>The deadline to achieve this is 1st September 2018</li> <li>Delivery plans have been submitted by practice groups to demonstrate how they will achieve this trajectory.</li> </ul>
RECOMMENDATION:	The committee are required to receive & consider the Business Case, and approve the continuation of this work programme.
