Leicester Risk Score was the suggested tool, this has been replaced with QDiabetes as this allows full integration within our clinical systems that enables inter-operability & automation of information. • Support from IM&T & Group Managers to practices beyond the launch of QOF+ and monitoring will be reported upon at quarterly intervals to demonstrate the progress/issues evident.
