KEY POINTS:	 In order to generate higher rates of referral into the programme the attached service specification has been prepared to enable a targeted approach to recruitment. Through targeted recruitment practices will be encouraged to contact patients who meet the participation criteria to take part in the research programme. A four stage approach has been defined, this will enable practices to ensure the right people are targeted and that practices are clear about the level of input required from them. Practices will be reimbursed for the activities detailed in the process/service specification. Wolverhampton practices have the choice of delivering this service on an individual basis and/or at scale via their respective practice group(s). The Primary Care Team will, as part of their ongoing joint working with the project monitor the rate of referral & conversion until closure.
RECOMMENDATION:	 The committee should note the Thrive Into Work Programme continues to be live in Wolverhampton. In order to improve uptake the attached service specification has been developed to enable as many patients as possible benefit from the initiative.
