The board concluded that the information provide substantial assurance although a series of actions were identified as follows:- Relate Counselling Service – to include referrals between IAPT & Relate. Breakdown of hours of service being utilised, patient numbers & patient feedback. GPFV amber/red items to be carried forward to the 2019/20 combined programme of work. PCN map to be issued to the board following approval of applications in May. Home Visiting Pilot – evaluation to be shared with the board to ensure overlap with other services & patient feedback have been recognised. QOF+ - consider other opportunities for in year development ie CVD, hypertension etc.
