PURPOSE OF REPORT:	<p>Safeguarding across the Black Country Needs to continue to work collaboratively, whilst maintaining local leadership and representation within the CCG's as four legal entities, as well as supporting our statutory partners, including each of the local authorities.</p> <p>A hub and spoke model arrangement for safeguarding would best facilitate this need, supported by a hosted Head of Service arrangement to oversee the operational functions, facilitated with a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the CCG;s to ensure robust and appropriate governance. This would not affect existing arrangements of accountability and representation at local boards, which would need to remain to provide strategic leadership with our statutory partners to this important agenda.</p>
